

# DOWNLOADING AND INSTALLING SOFTWARE FOR MACINTOSH

## Overview

Site-licensed software is available to Iowa State University faculty, staff, and students at no charge. To enable you to easily access and install the supported network software on your Macintosh computer, you can download the packages via the web. Access to site-licensed packages requires an Iowa State Net-ID.

Available software includes McAfee VirusScan, Eudora (email), NetPrint, Cisco VPN client, and JMP (statistics package), among others.

## Downloading Software

1. In your web browser, go to <http://www.it.iastate.edu/downloads/>.
2. Read license information and instructions for desired software.
3. Click the link in the Download column next to the software you want to download. If you select a site-licensed package, you will be asked to enter your Iowa State Net-ID and password to login.

## Installing Software

To install the software, double-click on the downloaded file and follow the on-screen instructions. Some software may be in the form of disk images; if so, double-clicking on the file will mount a disk image that will contain the software installer.
